# Garberg

**Morakniv Garberg is a powerful full tang knife designed to perform the toughest tasks it encounters.**

Manufactured at our factory in Mora, Sweden, it's the most robust knife we've ever made. The 3.2mm thick blade is made from high grade Swedish stainless steel, treated to make it even stronger and more durable. The blade has a Scandi-grind profile that makes it easy to keep sharp and a ground spine compatible with a fire starter. Whatever adventure you're on you don't want to be without it, making your Morakniv a part of you.

## Features

### Barrel shape

The barrel shape in the heart of the knife is strongly related to the heritage of Morakniv. In Sweden, the knife with the red coil shaped handled is probably as well known as the world famous Dalahorse. The latter are actually carved out with a Morakniv, in Mora.

### Pattern

The rhombus pattern is a traditional pattern that is present in many variations in Mora and the country side of Dalarna.

In the handle, the pattern provides a significantly improved grip. Beside its high functionality, it also pays a tribute to our region and our is history.

A pleasant detail is that the lock that connects the knife and sheath, naturally blends into the pattern.

### Scandi grind

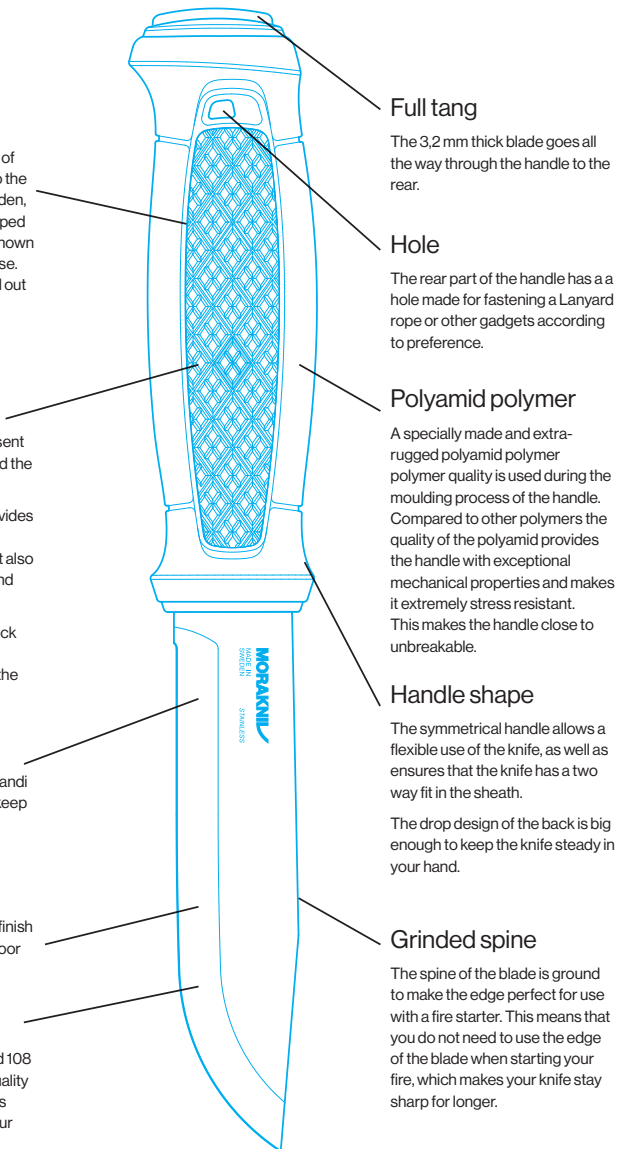
The knife is grinded with a scandi grind witch makes it easy to keep sharp.

### Blade finish

The blade has a semi-matte finish appreciated among the outdoor group of people.

### Steel

The blade is 3,2 mm thick and 108 mm long. It is made of high quality Swedish stainless steel that is treated to highest quality in our own factory.



### Full tang

The 3,2 mm thick blade goes all the way through the handle to the rear.

### Hole

The rear part of the handle has a hole made for fastening a Lanyard rope or other gadgets according to preference.

### Polyamid polymer

A specially made and extra-rugged polyamid polymer quality is used during the moulding process of the handle. Compared to other polymers the quality of the polyamid provides the handle with exceptional mechanical properties and makes it extremely stress resistant. This makes the handle close to unbreakable.

### Handle shape

The symmetrical handle allows a flexible use of the knife, as well as ensures that the knife has a two way fit in the sheath.

The drop design of the back is big enough to keep the knife steady in your hand.

### Grinded spine

The spine of the blade is ground to make the edge perfect for use with a fire starter. This means that you do not need to use the edge of the blade when starting your fire, which makes your knife stay sharp for longer.

# Packaging

With this new generation of Morakniv knives, we are applying an entirely new design to our boxes and packages. Of course they're in line with the genuine and natural Morakniv look.

Naturally colored paper on the packages together with the birch wood, creates that clean Scandinavian look that is appreciated all over the world. This also ensures make the knives a natural center of attention. At the same time, the exclusive feel of a thought through packaging solution adds to the customer value.

As distributor or retailer, the packages are developed to function as smoothly as possible when in transport, in stock and in store. All models share the basic geometry, which makes them easy to fit together and display side by side on the shelves or stands.
